Information

Where Will My Child Attend School?

Your children will attend schools in the district in the county in which you reside. Families that reside on post attend Fort Liberty Schools, K-8th grade. Retirees living on post with school age children are not eligible for on-post schools. All high school students residing in Fort Liberty are districted for EE Smith High School (Cumberland County Schools), and all high school students residing in Linden Oaks are districted for Overhills High School (Harnett County Schools).

This information will explain your options for selecting a school of choice **if** you've already found a place to live and you do not want to attend the school your children are assigned to.

I Live Off Post, But I Want My Child to Attend On Post Schools

- If you are living temporarily off post and waiting for on post housing, you may enroll in Fort Liberty Schools if you are within 90 school days of residing on post.
- If you permanently live off post, you will **not** be able attend schools on post.
- There are **no** exceptions to policy.

I Live Off Post And I Want My Child To Attend A Different School

- Requesting To Attend Another School In The Same County
 - In all counties, you can request for an out of district transfer within the county.
 - When at all possible, select the school you want your child to attend PRIOR to selecting a residence.
 - Remember to double check the assigned school with Fort Liberty School Support Services or the school district.
- Cumberland County School Choice Program
