PUBLIC/ON POST SCHOOL DISTRICTS

- Students attend schools where they reside. Fort Liberty Schools: You must reside on post, or w/in 90 school days.
- Cumberland County Schools (CCS) has a school choice program. Applications during Jan-Feb for the next school year. Visit CCS website for info.
- Some CCS choice options are not available when enrolling in the middle of the school year or after the student's freshman year.
- Children must be 5 on or before Aug 31st to be eligible for Kindergarten. For Fort Liberty Schools, the child must be 5 on or before Sept 1st.
- All high schools in the area are on a 4x4 schedule. Please consider this schedule change prior to transitioning with a high school student.
- The district high school for on post families is EE Smith High. The district high school for the Linden Oaks Housing is Overhills High School.
- Some schools districts have schools with uniform policies, year round programs, and Early College Programs.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- Birth Certificate and Immunization Records
- Health Assessment (school will provide form). Sport Physical may be required.
- Proof of Parent/Custodian Address
- Copy of orders (on post schools only)
- Custody or guardian papers filed through the court (if applicable).
- Bring copies of any applicable special and gifted education information.

YOUTH SPONSORSHIP

Youth sponsors help relocated youth become more familiar with their new home. The program provides the youth with a sponsor and Family Members with a welcome packet. The sponsorship program introduces youth to the activities offered by CYS. Contact your gaining installation School Liaison Officer to request a youth sponsor for your teen.
